Students will complete a range of units, and must successfully complete 160 hours of work placement to be awarded their qualification. Sample*:

- Support children's health, safety and wellbeing
- Nurture babies and toddlers
- Work effectively in children's education and care
- Support children to connect with the natural environment
- Support the holistic learning and development of children
- Provide experiences to support children's play and learning
- Use an approved learning framework to guide practice
- Observe children to inform practice
- Encourage understanding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples' cultures
- Provide First Aid in an education and care setting
- Follow basic food safety practices
- Develop positive and respectful relationships with children
- Support inclusion and diversity
- Work with diverse people
- Meet legal and ethical obligations in children's education and care
- Identify and respond to children and young people at risk
- Participate in workplace health and safety
