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Our NDIS Disability Support Services

• Support Coordination

A support Coordinator will help you to understand your NDIS plan and support you to connect with the most appropriate and affordable service providers. They will also connect with all your service providers to make sure you achieve your NDIS goals and prepare you for any future NDIS plan reviews.

• Plan Management

A Plan Manager will manage your NDIS budget and pay your service provider invoices.

• Support to attend appointments

• Assistance to participate in life skills and capacity building activities

We have many bilingual staff and support workers and will always try to connect you with carers from your own language/background.
